ENTRY RULES AND GUIDELINES:

- Electronic Submission: Submit entries electronically from January 5 30, 2026. No entries will be accepted after this date.
- Image Format: Submit JPEG images no larger than 3MB each. Label each file with the artist's name, title, media, size of the work, and price (if for sale).
- Submission Deadline for Accepted Works: Once notified by the jury, deliver display-ready works (framed, wired, and ready to hang) to the gallery between February 23 27, 2026. No entries will be accepted after this date.
- Assistance: If you need help matting, framing, wiring, stabilizing, etc., contact an art professor for guidance.
- Artist Responsibility: Artists are responsible for delivering and picking up artwork(s).
- **Submission Limitations:** You may submit a maximum of 2 works across any one or combination of the following categories: Ceramics, Digital Media/Graphic Design/Illustration, Drawing, Mixed Media, Painting, Photography, Printmaking, Sculpture, and Two-Dimensional Design.
- Eligibility: All current CFCC students enrolled in the Spring 2026 semester are eligible.
- · Originality: Works must have been completed within the past 2 years and must not have been previously displayed in the Wilma W. Daniels Gallery.
- Ineligible Works: Mass-produced or photocopied works are not allowed unless copied or appropriated images are integral to the work's design.
- Artwork Pickup: After the exhibition, collect your artwork(s) from WWD Gallery between May 4-8, 2026. Sign out your artwork upon retrieval. CFCC is not responsible for artwork left after this date.
- · Handling Policy: WWD/CFCC will handle all artwork with care but is not responsible for any damages incurred during storage, installation, or the exhibition.
- Size Restrictions:
 - 2D works, including the frame, must not exceed 44" on the longest side.
 - 3D works must not exceed 48" on the longest side and 84" in height. All 3D work must be freestanding, stable, and portable by two people.
- Usage Permissions: By submitting your artwork, you grant WWD Gallery and CFCC permission to use images of your work for promotional and advertising purposes.
